

Changes in past 10 years

Staff changes, demographic changes as our congregations becomes a commuter increasing numbers of Asians, greater church with high cost of real estate, sharingfacilities with Korean Presbyterian retirement of long term members, need Congregation, some capital improvements, for support system for those facing contributions to Scotts Valley and Hollister emplyment difficulties congregations, fewer volunteers

Changes anticipated in 5-10 years

Continuing demographic changes with financial stress for newer members,

SPECIAL COMMUNITY NEEDS AND HUMAN NEEDS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF YOUR CONGREGATION

At the Present time

Changing ethnic community, vounger families moving out, increased housing costs; declining school age population, over 50% of income goes to pay staff salaries

Changes in past 10 years

Two income families a necessity, changing moral climate with live-in couples, AIDS, drug abuse, alcoholism, teenage pregnancies now as standard

Changes anticipate in 5-10 years

Cost factors may force congregations to find other methods for support, church and clrergy having less visible and respected position in the community, continued breakdown of families, consumer mentality, loss of denonminational loyalties
