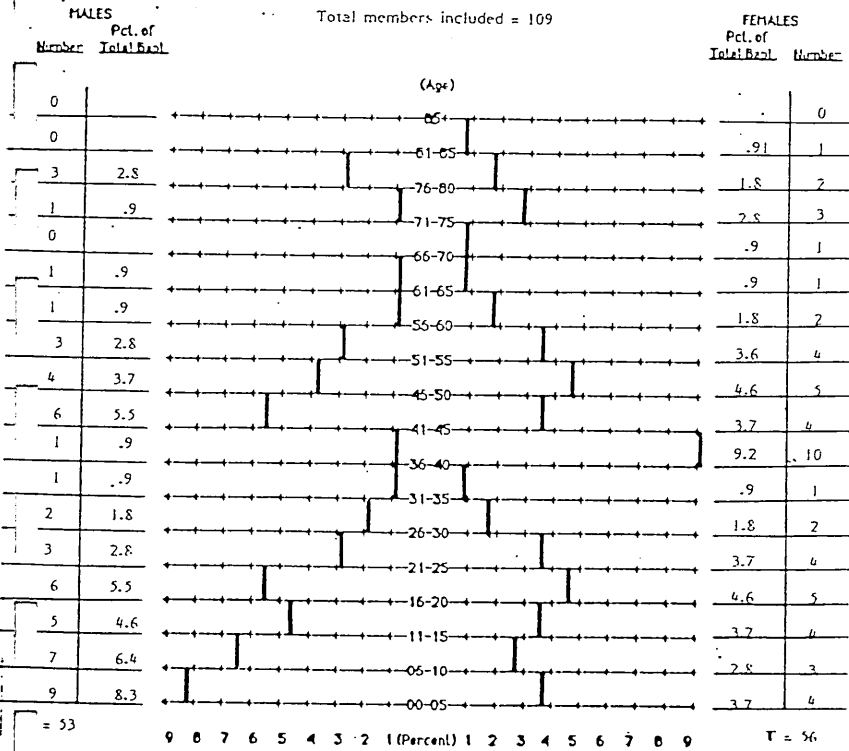

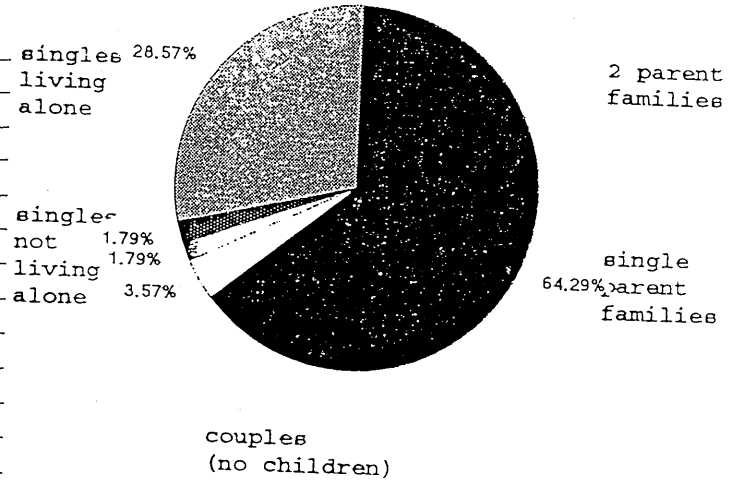

### AGE-SEX PYRAMID

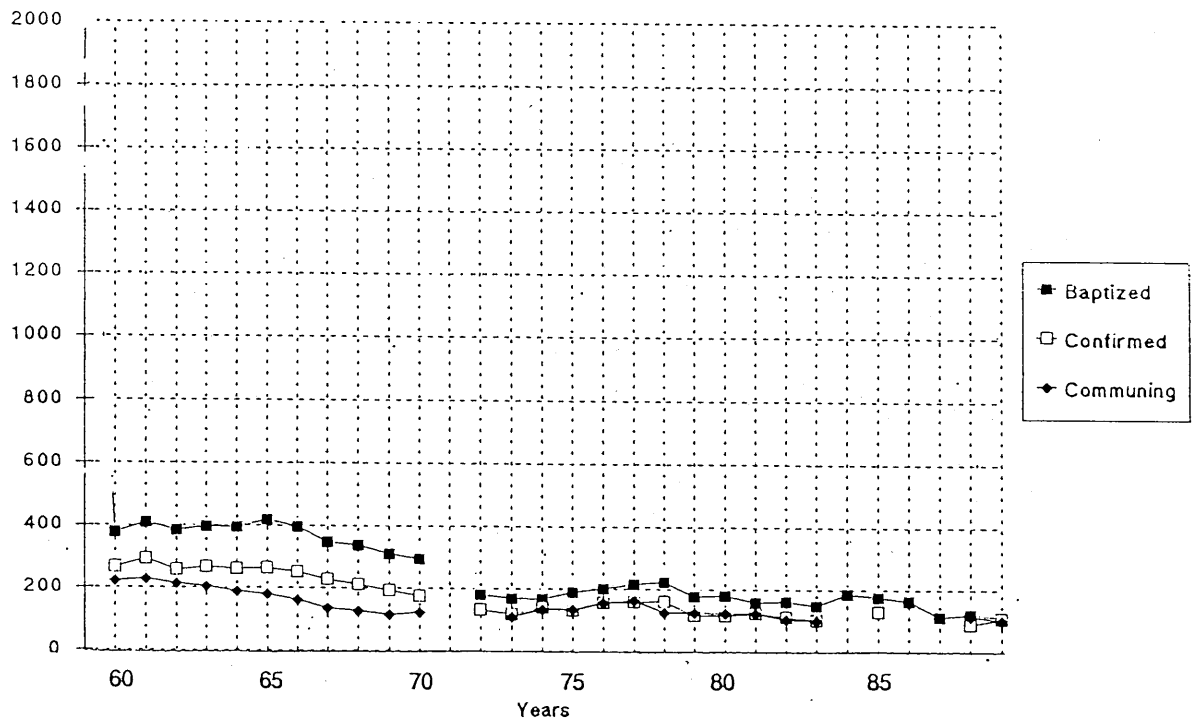


### MAKE-UP OF HOUSEHOLDS
