- f. That the functions of the SCVLP will be to:
 - 1) facilitate communication among congregations of the parish,
 - assist in planning and in implementing programs and events to strengthen ministries,
 - 3) plan new ministry development,
 - 4) implement strategic planning goals,
 - 5) assist in allocating human and financial resources,
 - relate to others committed to justice/advocacy and service/ministry, and
 - 7) represent the ELCA in the public arena in Santa Clara County.
- g. That funding for operation of the SCVLP come from congregations and ministries within the parish.
- h. That the organization of the parish be:
 - 1) an annual or semi-annual assembly with lay and clergy delegates selected by congregations in the same way and the same proportion as they are selected for synod assemblies;
 - 2) a parish council that meets quarterly with one lay <u>or</u> one clergy voting member from each of the 22 organized congregations elected by the congregation for 3-year staggered terms, each with a 2-term limit, and one lay <u>or</u> one clergy voting member from each of the following four groups of special ministries elected by those groups of ministries for 3year staggered terms, each with a 2-term limit:
 - a) schools (pre-schools, early learning centers, day-care centers, schools, etc.);
 - b) agencies and institutions (Lutheran Campus Ministry, Lutheran Social Services, Sunny View Home, etc.);
 - c) youth ministries (SLY, Santa Clara Valley Lutheran Youth, etc.); and
 - d) other special ministries not represented in any way in the above two categories (chaplaincies, etc.);
 - 3) two officers, a Dean and a Secretary/ Treasurer, elected in alternating years by the assembly for terms of two years, each with a 2-term limit;
 - 4) four standing committees: Outreach/Evangelism Service/Ministry Advocacy/Justice

Leadership Development & Support each comprised of 5 or 6 members of the Parish Council and, as needed, other co-opted members from the congregations of the parish,
